PURPOSE OF THE GRANT

Is to enhance the likelihood of Māori trainees successfully completing CTA funded training programmes

ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDING

Māori support funding applies to actual and reasonable costs associated with

- Mentoring,
- Cultural Supervision
- Cultural Development

In conjunction with mentoring and cultural supervision **Cultural Development activities** may be part of the Support Plan and include:

- Cultural resources
- Membership to Māori Health Professional Organisations
- Cultural activities including Kaumātua and peer support

NB: Support funding is up to a maximum of \$2,000 (excluding GST) per trainee programme Training Unit, but may be less depending on factors such as available budget. Funding is on a prorated basis for part-time study.

Application Process

The applicant emails the Nursing Directorate and registers their interest in accessing cultural support.

ELIGIBILITY

The following selection criteria must be met in order to be eligible for CTA Māori support funding

- Application for Māori Support funding is open to any person who is an trainee enrolled in a CTA funded training programme whose name appears in the CTA Report One Database
- Eligible trainees must have whakapapa and cultural links to whanau, hapu and iwi
- The trainee must negotiate and agree a written support plan
- A written record of mentor/supervisor meetings is maintained
- CTA Māori Support Policy criteria are met (refer to CTA Coordinator or Māori Health Support Team for details).
- CTA will determine the eligibility of applicants and that determination is final.
